1	American Revolution	The conflict (1775-1783) when the British colonies (now the United States of America) rebelled against British rule and fought and won the right to self-governance.
1	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
1	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
1	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
1	constitutional	related to the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled.
1	dilemma	a difficult problem
1	enactment	establishment by legal act
1	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
1	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
1	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
1	impressive	something that is awesome or imposing
1	legislate	to make or enact laws
1	legislature	the group of people who make laws
1	liberty	the power or right to do as one pleases, to be free
1	regulations	to control or maintain by means of rules and laws
1	reign	hold a royal office, for example, a Queen
1	revolution	forceable overthrow of a government
1	safeguard	to protect from harm, or a measure taken to do so
