100	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
100	Civil Rights	rights of personal liberty guaranteed to U.S. citizens by the 13th and 14th amendments to the Constitution and by acts of Congress
100	debate	argue about, often in a formal matter
100	George Washington	also known as the Father of our country. He was an American commander-in-chief of the colonial Armies during the American Revolution and subsequently became the first president of the United States
100	immunity	able to resist a particular disease
100	indigenous people	earliest inhabitants of a place
100	labor	hard work or the act of working
100	Martin Luther King, Jr.	Baptist minister and leader of the civil rights movement in the U.S. from the mid-1950s until his assassination in 1969
100	patriotic	having or expressing devotion to and vigorous support for one's country
100	Pilgrims	a group of English Puritans who emigrated to America to pursue religious freedom, landing in what is now Massachusetts
