13	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process
13	committee	a group of people usually appointed or elected from a larger body to complete a function
13	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
13	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
13	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
13	executive	the branch of our government that carries out the laws
13	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
13	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
13	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
13	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
13	judicial	relating to a court or judge
13	legislate	to make or enact laws
13	legislate	to make or enact laws
13	liberties	rights or privileges, especially those that have been written into law
13	liberty	the power or right to do as one pleases, to be free
13	nominate	to propose or formally enter a candidate for election
13	senator	a member of the smaller, upper assembly in the U.S. Congress
13	tyranny	rule by a cruel and oppressive government, often without legal right
13	violate	break, fail to respect, or fail to comply with something
