15	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
15	authority	the power to give orders and expect them to be followed
15	committee	a group of people usually appointed or elected from a larger body to complete a function
15	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
15	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
15	debate	argue about, often in a formal matter
15	drudgery	work that is hard or dull but requires little skill
15	enactment	establishment by legal act
15	executive	the branch of our government that carries out the laws
15	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
15	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
15	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
15	Great Depression	the worst economic downturn in the history of the industrialized world, lasting from 1929 to 1942
15	unceasing	something that does not stop or end
