16	administrative state	used to describe executive branch administrative agencies exercising the power to create, adjudicate, and enforce their own rules.
16	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
16	Chief Justice	the principal judge of a court of justice - as in the Supreme Court
16	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
16	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
16	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
16	enactment	establishment by legal act
16	essence	the most important part of something, that which characterizes something
16	executive	the branch of our government that carries out the laws
16	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
16	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
16	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
16	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
16	Justice (Noun)	A judge on the Supreme Court
16	legislate	to make or enact laws
16	legislature	the group of people who make laws
16	liberty	the power or right to do as one pleases, to be free
16	principle	main or most important
16	proposed	offered for discussion or consideration
