17	ambassador	someone sent by one country to represent their interests in another country
17	cabinet	a council advising a president, sovereign, etc., especially the group of ministers or executives responsible for the government of a nation.
17	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
17	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
17	ensure	make certain of something
17	executive	the branch of our government that carries out the laws
17	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
17	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
17	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
17	impeach	to charge a public officer with misconduct
17	liberty	the power or right to do as one pleases, to be free
17	negotiate	to deal or bargain with others
17	nominate	to propose or formally enter a candidate for election
17	originate	create or initiate
17	paramount	the most important
17	reserved	kept for a particular person or purpose
17	responsibility	to have control and accountability for something
17	Senate	the smaller, upper assembly in the U.S. Congress, made up of two senators from each state
17	solely	all alone without anything or anyone else
