18	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process

18	election	choosing an official through a formal, organized vote
18	enactment	establishment by legal act
18	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government

18	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
