2	amend	change or update part of a text
2	American Revolution	The conflict (1775-1783) when the British colonies (now the United States of America) rebelled against British rule and fought and won the right to self-governance.
2	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
2	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process
2	commerce	the buying and selling of goods and services
2	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
2	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
2	ensure	make certain of something
2	enumerated	listed, numbered
2	establish	to set up (a government/organization or system of rules) on a permanent basis
2	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
2	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
2	fundamental	of critical importance
2	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
2	immigration	moving to a country for the purpose of permanent residence
2	interstate	between two or more states
2	liberties	rights or privileges, especially those that have been written into law
2	liberty	the power or right to do as one pleases, to be free
2	patent	the grant an inventor or originator of exclusive property rights to their creation for a certain set period of time
2	president	the elected head of a republic
2	regulate	to control or maintain by means of rules and laws
