Question #	Vocab Word	Definition
20	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
20	ballot box	a sealed box into which voters put completed ballots.
20	clause	a separate section of a document
20	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
20	election	choosing an official through a formal, organized vote
20	freedom	the power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants, without hindrance or restraint
20	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
20	representative	a person chosen to speak or act for others
20	senator	a member of the smaller, upper assembly in the U.S. Congress
