21	advocate (verb)	to recommend publicly, or speak in favor of
21	apportionment	the determination of the proportional number of members each U.S. state sends to the House of Representatives, based on population figures.
21	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
21	census	a survey of a population to find out information about its makeup
21	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
21	constituent	a voting member of the group of people represented by a particular member of Congress
21	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
21	delegation	a group of representatives
21	expand	to make larger
21	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
21	population	all the residents of a certain area
21	representative	a person chosen to speak or act for others
