23	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
23	commission	a duty or job
23	committee	a group of people usually appointed or elected from a larger body to complete a function
23	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
23	constituent	a voting member of the group of people represented by a particular member of Congress
23	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
23	delegate	a person sent to represent others at an assembly or meeting
23	earmark	designate for a particular purpose
23	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
23	election	choosing an official through a formal, organized vote
23	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
23	framework	an essential, supporting structure
23	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
23	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
23	notorious	well known for a bad reason
23	policy	a course or principle of action adopted by a government
23	representative	a person chosen to speak or act for others
