Question #	Vocab Word	Definition
25	consent	to agree to something
25	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
25	delegation	a group of representatives
25	democracy	government by the people, exercised either directly, or through elected representatives; majority rule.
25	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
25	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
25	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
25	majority	the larger part of a population
25	minority	a group of less than half of a population
25	population	all the residents of a certain area
25	populous	having a large number of residents
25	representative	a person chosen to speak or act for others
25	republic	a government in which the power rests in a group of citizens who have been elected by the population, and has a president who is either elected by the people or nominated by the elected body
25	safeguard	to protect from harm, or a measure taken to do so
