27	advocate (verb)	to recommend publicly, or speak in favor of
27	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process
27	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
27	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
27	convenient	something that easily fits
27	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
27	election	choosing an official through a formal, organized vote
27	leeway	wiggle room, the amount freedom to move or act that is available
27	president	the elected head of a republic
27	republic	a government in which the power rests in a group of citizens who have been elected by the population, and has a president who is either elected by the people or nominated by the elected body
27	worship	to respect and feel adoration for a deity
