29	administration	those who manage the public affairs of the government
29	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process
29	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
29	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
29	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
29	executive	the branch of our government that carries out the laws
29	Founders	individuals who establish something such as a country or government
29	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
29	legislate	to make or enact laws
29	seldom	rarely, not often
29	Senate	the smaller, upper assembly in the U.S. Congress, made up of two senators from each state
