30	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
30	First Amendment	the first of 10 amendments making up the Bill of Rights. It protects freedom of speech, religion, and the press as well as the right to peaceful protest and to petition the government
30	inaugural	marking the beginning of a period in office or the start of something
30	pneumonia	a lung inflammation caused by infection
30	president	the elected head of a republic
30	resign	to leave a position voluntarily
30	succeeded	came after or took the place of
