34	Article One	the first of seven Articles making up the Constitution, giving all legislative power to the Congress
34	clause	a separate section of a document
34	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
34	constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
34	George Washington	also known as the Father of our country. He was an American commander-in-chief of the colonial Armies during the American Revolution and subsequently became the first president of the United States
34	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
