37	clause	a separate section of a document
37	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
37	dispassionately	without excess emotion
37	dispute	a disagreement or argument
37	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
37	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
37	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
