38	administration	those who manage the public affairs of the government
38	assert	to state a fact or belief confidently and forcefully
38	authority	the power to give orders and expect them to be followed
38	Chief Justice	the principal judge of a court of justice - as in the Supreme Court
38	commission	a duty or job
38	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
38	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
38	ensure	make certain of something
38	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
38	formal	done in accordance with rules of convention or etiquette
38	James Madison	Fourth President of the United States, one of the Founders/Framers, and one of the authors of the Federalist Papers
38	judicial review	when the Supreme Court reviews the constitutional validity of an act of legislature
38	judiciary	all the judges in a country
38	Justice (Noun)	A judge on the Supreme Court
38	legal	within the defined rules
38	liberties	rights or privileges, especially those that have been written into law
38	principle	a comprehensive and fundamental law, doctrine, or assumption
38	republic	a government in which the power rests in a group of citizens who have been elected by the population, and has a president who is either elected by the people or nominated by the elected body
38	succeeded	came after or took the place of
38	Supreme Court	the highest judicial court
38	theoretical	something that exists only as speculation and is not yet a reality
38	unconstitutional	something that does not follow or hold to the rules or practices that a country has agreed to and made law, as ruled by the court.
