39	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
39	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
39	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
39	Great Depression	the worst economic downturn in the history of the industrialized world, lasting from 1929 to 1940
39	judiciary	all the judges in a country
39	Justice (Noun)	A judge on the Supreme Court
39	partisan	strong support for one's own political causes that interferes with the ability to compromise
39	political	relating to, involving, or part of the actions of a state, country, or their government
