43	authority	the power to give orders and expect them to be followed
43	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process
43	civic	relating to government, citizenship, or community affairs
43	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
43	delegated	entrusted a job or duty to someone
43	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
43	enactment	establishment by legal act
43	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
43	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
43	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
43	governor	an elected public official (in the United States over a state)
43	guarantee	an assurance for the fulfillment of a condition
43	House of Representatives	one of the two houses of the bicameral United States Congress, established in 1789 by the Constitution of the United States. Representation on the house is based on population of the states, and they are elected every two years.
43	political	relating to, involving, or part of the actions of a state, country, or their government
43	president	the elected head of a republic
43	republican	a form of government in which power flows from the people
43	safeguard	to protect from harm, or a measure taken to do so
