48	advocate (noun)	a person who speaks in favor of another person (sometimes in a court of law) or in favor a course of action
48	amend	change or update part of a text
48	amendment	a change or addition to a piece of legislation
48	citizen	a legally recognized resident of an area, granted by birthright or a naturalization process
48	civic	relating to government, citizenship, or community affairs
48	Civil Rights	rights of personal liberty guaranteed to U.S. citizens by the 13th and 14th amendments to the Constitution and by acts of Congress
48	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
48	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
48	debate	argue about, often in a formal matter
48	expand	to make larger
48	Interpret	explain the meaning of
48	legal	within the defined rules
48	legislature	the group of people who make laws
48	opposed	wanting to put an end to or prevent
48	outlawed	made illegal
48	pioneered	the first to use or apply some process, or knowledge
48	poll taxes	a tax levied on every adult, often linked to the right to vote

48	ratified	signed and made official
48	suffrage	the right to vote
