51	amend	change or update part of a text
51	assembly	a group of people gathered in one place for a common purpose
51	censor	to suppress or delete anything considered objectionable
51	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
51	despise	to look down on with disrespect or aversion
51	elect	choose (someone) by voting to hold public office or some other position
51	expression	a particular word, phrase, or group of words
51	First Amendment	the first of 10 amendments making up the Bill of Rights. It protects freedom of speech, religion, and the press as well as the right to peaceful protest and to petition the government
51	free market	an economic system in which prices are determined by unrestricted competition between privately owned businesses
51	freedom	the power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants, without hindrance or restraint
51	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
51	guarantee	an assurance for the fulfillment of a condition
51	inciting	to encourage, urge, or prompt to action
51	jury	the group of people who take the responsibility to give a verdict in a trial based on the presented evidence.
51	libel	unjustly damaging someone's reputation in any form other than spoken words
51	petition	make or present a formal request to (an authority) with respect to a cause
51	right to bear arms	the right protected by the 2nd amendment to the Constitution
51	safeguard	to protect from harm, or a measure taken to do so
51	slander	a false and malicious spoken statement
51	Supreme Court	the highest judicial court
51	symbolic	-serving as a symbol
51	treason	a violation of allegiance to one's country
