52	allegiance	loyalty or commitment to a cause or set of principles
52	amend	change or update part of a text
52	clause	a separate section of a document
52	compulsion	the act of forcing someone to do something
52	constellation	a group of related qualities or things; example: the Articles and Amendments of the Constitution
52	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
52	constitutional	related to the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled.
52	dissent	to disagree with the opinion of others
52	First Amendment	the first of 10 amendments making up the Bill of Rights. It protects freedom of speech, religion, and the press as well as the right to peaceful protest and to petition the government
52	freedom	the power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants, without hindrance or restraint
52	generation	the average period, generally considered to be about thirty years, during which children are born and grow up, become adults, and begin to have children of their own
52	guarantee	an assurance for the fulfillment of a condition
52	Justice (Noun)	A judge on the Supreme Court
52	landmark case	a court case that established a significant new legal principle
52	nationalism	loyalty and devotion to a nation
52	orthodox	conforming to beliefs, attitudes, or modes of conduct that are generally approved
52	Pledge of Allegiance	an expression of allegiance to the flag and republic of the United States of America
52	prescribe	to declare something as a rule that should be carried out
52	promotion	activity that provides encouragement for the furtherance of a cause or aim
52	republic	a government in which the power rests in a group of citizens who have been elected by the population, and has a president who is either elected by the people or nominated by the elected body

52	restriction	a limiting condition or measure, especially a legal one
