56	advocate (noun)	a person who speaks in favor of another person (sometimes in a court of law) or in favor a course of action
56	amend	change or update part of a text
56	assembly	a group of people gathered in one place for a common purpose
56	census	a survey of a population to find out information about its makeup
56	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
56	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
56	consumption	the act or process of using something
56	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
56	First Amendment	the first of 10 amendments making up the Bill of Rights. It protects freedom of speech, religion, and the press as well as the right to peaceful protest and to petition the government
56	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
56	levies	the imposition of an assessment or tax
56	population	all the residents of a certain area
56	ratified	signed and made official
56	Sixteenth Amendment	the Amendment that gives Congress the power to collect taxes on incomes, no matter the source
