59	Articles of Confederation	document which served as a bridge between the initial government by the Continental Congress and the federal government created by the Constitution
59	Bill of Rights	the first ten amendments to the US Constitution, ratified in 1791 and guaranteeing such rights as the freedoms of speech, assembly, and worship.
59	Civil Rights	rights of personal liberty guaranteed to U.S. citizens by the 13th and 14th amendments to the Constitution and by acts of Congress
59	competition	when two or more parties are trying to achieve something that only one of them can
59	confederation	an alliance or league
59	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
59	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
59	held in trust	a term used to describe property held by a person who is not the owner but who is a trustee or agent.
59	immunity	able to resist a particular disease
59	population	all the residents of a certain area
59	ravaged	to cause severe and extensive damage to something
59	restriction	a limiting condition or measure, especially a legal one
59	self-governance	having control or rule over oneself
59	sovereignty	the authority of a state to govern itself
