64	American Revolution	The conflict (1775-1783) when the British colonies (now the United States of America) rebelled against British rule and fought and won the right to self-governance.
64	colony	a territory under the rule of another country

64	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
64	New Sweden	a colony settled by Swedish settlers along the Delaware River
64	revolution	forceable overthrow of a government
