66	Articles of Confederation	document which served as a bridge between the initial government by the Continental Congress and the federal government created by the Constitution
66	Bill of Rights	the first ten amendments to the US Constitution, ratified in 1791 and guaranteeing such rights as the freedoms of speech, assembly, and worship.
66	colony	a territory under the rule of another country
66	confederation	an alliance or league
66	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
66	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
66	delegate	a person sent to represent others at an assembly or meeting
66	executive	the branch of our government that carries out the laws
66	federal	relating to the national government as opposed to state or local government
66	Founders	individuals who establish something such as a country or government
66	Framers	the men who helped shape the Constitution of the United States of America
