74	Civil Rights	rights of personal liberty guaranteed to U.S. citizens by the 13th and 14th amendments to the Constitution and by acts of Congress
74	commission	a duty or job
74	Confederacy	the 11 southern states during their secession from the United States
74	confederation	an alliance or league
74	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
74	criticized	to find fault with
74	dissolution	breaking a bond, tie, union, partnership, etc.
74	forbid	to not allow
74	immigration	moving to a country for the purpose of permanent residence
74	indivisible	cannot be divided
74	inevitable	certain to happen
74	intertwined	to connect, link, or twist two or more things closely
74	irreconcilable	incapable of compromise; implacably opposed

74	Republican	relating to the nature of a republic; OR one of two political parties
