76	Civil War	war between opposing groups of citizens in the same country. The American civil war was a war between the northern and southern states.

76	Confederacy	the 11 southern states during their secession from the United States
76	Constitution	the principles, rights, and/or precedents by which a country, state, or organization agrees to be ruled
76	constitutional power	defines the roles, powers, and structure of different entities within the government and the basic rights of citizens
76	emancipation	to free a person from bondage or slavery
76	Emancipation Proclamation	President Lincoln's proclamation freeing the slaves in the territories still in rebellion against the Union

76	Frederick Douglass	an escaped slave who became a prominent activist, author, and public speaker and was a leader in the abolitionist movement
76	freedom	the power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants, without hindrance or restraint
