Question #	Vocab Word	Definition
81	armistice	a temporary stop of warfare by agreement between the combatants; a temporary truce
81	Battle of the Bulge	a deciding battle against Hitler's troops in Belgium which paved the way for the Allied victory
81	campaign	a connected group of military operations forming a specific phase of war
81	Congress	a legislative body - in the United States, it is a bicameral (two part) system made up of the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives
81	fascist	a member of a political movement or party that puts the group above the individual and has no tolerance for any opposition. Also characterized by complete control of industry.
81	government	the system by which a nation, state, or community handles its affairs of state
81	infamy	well known for a bad reason
81	invaded	entered a country or region to control or occupy it
81	Midway	epic battle between the U.S. Navy and the Imperial Japanese Navy. The U.S. Navy's decisive victory dashed Japan's hopes of neutralizing the U.S. as a naval power and turned the tide of WWII in the Pacific.
81	monumental	great in importance, extent, or size
81	Nazi	a member of the German fascist party controlling Germany from 1933 to 1945 under Adolf Hitler
81	occupied France	areas of northern and western France occupied by the Nazis during WWII
81	ousted	to remove from by force
81	Pearl Harbor	U.S. naval base near Honolulu, Hawaii that suffered a devastating surprise attack by the Japanese which led President Franklin Roosevelt to declare war on Japan and involve the U.S. in World War II
81	surrender	to stop resisting something, to give up
